



## 1.0 Summary

Associated Asphalt Contracting Ltd is dedicated to delivering services which consistently satisfy the requirements of our stakeholders. To this end we have undertaken a baseline assessment to establish the CO<sub>2</sub>e impact of our operations. We support the Government's efforts to decarbonise the public sector and comply with Procurement Policy Note [PPN] 06/21, and we commit independently to achieve net zero carbon emissions across our scope 1, 2 and 3 by 2040.

## 2.0 Principles

How we plan to achieve this:

- Data – ensuring that our data is robust and collected at a frequency that aids carbon reduction
- Avoidance – looking for alternatives to carbon intense activities and working with suppliers and customers to do so
- Efficiency – where carbon is emitted, using the best available working practices to keep related emissions to a minimum
- Power source substitution – moving sources of energy to cleaner forms
- Off and In-Setting – internalising the cost of carbon into our business either directly as part of our transactions or through investments into improved technologies

## 3.0 Responsibilities

We take our commitments to the environment seriously and as a private business we can take pro-active and rapid decisions to take advantage of emergent technology to help shrink our footprint. We will update our plans as the maturity of our approach and comprehension develops, seeking improved technology, processes and actively influencing our supply chain partners in favour of lower carbon options.

## 4.0 Baseline Assessment

Our emissions have been calculated rather than measured at this point in our carbon management journey. A key focus of our efforts going forward will be in terms of accuracy of data.
